Remembering Katrina Clark

Connecticut lost a true health care champion on August 25 with the passing of one of the Community Health Network of Connecticut Foundation's founding and current board members, Katrina Clark.

After graduating from the Yale School of Public Health, Katrina joined the Fair Haven Community Health Center as Executive Director in 1971. At that time, it was a Clinic operating two nights a week out of Columbus School on Grand Avenue. Since then, the Center has grown to serve more than 18,000 patients and employ 200 staff members at 13 locations. From day one, the Center has focused on delivering high-quality health care services to the underserved residents of Fair Haven.



"Katrina was a remarkable individual and devoted public servant," said John Federico, MD, chair of the Foundation's Board of Directors. "She earned the admiration and respect of Foundation Board members, of colleagues and of all who knew or benefited from her endeavors."

"Katrina's impact in the New Haven community will live on through the legacy of the Fair Haven Community Health Center, and the many people she worked with and mentored over the 40-plus years she served as executive director," said Patti Scussel, executive director of the Foundation. "She cared so much about the people and community she lived in. We are

lucky to have had the opportunity to know her as a friend and a colleague."
