Bridgeport Rescue Mission, Bridgeport, CT

The Bridgeport Rescue Mission provides vital services to men, women and children faced with hunger, homelessness, and addiction, offering them help to heal and return to the community as a whole.

Our Piece of the Pie, Inc., Hartford, CT

Our Piece of the Pie, Inc. is dedicated to empowering youth with the key competencies needed to overcome barriers and succeed in education and employment. Focus areas are youth development, academic achievement, and workforce readiness.

LARC, Torrington, CT

The Litchfield County ARC (LARC) works cooperatively with others in developing opportunities for individuals with intellectual/developmental disabilities, including Autism, to reach their maximum level of independence; experience presence and participation; make decisions about their lives and their futures; and live with respect and dignity.

Columbus House, Inc., Middletown, CT

Columbus House, Inc. provides shelter for women, men, Veterans, and families. Shelter services include case management, employment training programs, education, and health services. The Middlesex Family Shelter provides beds and case management for approximately 20 families per year.



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Youth Continuum, Inc., New Haven, CT

Youth Continuum, Inc. supports 1,000 to 1,500 young people annually through emergency, residential, and community services. The new Y2Y New Haven initiative, which is operated in collaboration with student leaders throughout New Haven and the Y2Y network, is a student-run homeless shelter for young adults (ages 18 – 24). Y2Y New Haven is modeled after the Harvard Square shelter, which has served more than 300 young adults since 2015.

The Salvation Army, New London, CT

The Salvation Army provides services for the homeless, abused or abandoned, disadvantaged, displaced, elderly and youth. The food pantry offers free groceries year-round to anyone who needs them.

The Cornerstone, Vernon, CT

The Cornerstone's mission is to keep all people safe, fed, housed, and clothed. It provides help to the community through a soup kitchen, two shelters, a food pantry clothing bank, and youth/outreach center.

Windham Region No Freeze Project, Inc., Willimantic, CT

The Windham Region No Freeze Project, Inc. is dedicated to the short- and long-term survival of adults experiencing homelessness. Services include intakes and assessment that link to housing, access to clean water and hygiene services, and connections to area human services organizations.
