Top-Rated Course to Host Cornell Scott Memorial Golf Classic
Community Health Network of Connecticut Foundation, Inc.'s annual charity golf tournament
Returns to the prestigious Lake of Isles at Foxwoods Resort Casino

WALLINGFORD, Conn. – For its sixth year, the Cornell Scott Memorial Golf Classic will return to one the top-rated, private courses in the country—Lake of Isles' South Course.

Lake of Isles' South Course is a 36-hole, Rees Jones-designed golf club located across the street from Foxwoods Resort Casino. The course has a 7,300 yard layout and winds its way through 900 acres of wooded countryside and around a 90-acre lake, according to its website. Lake of Isles is introducing state-of-the-art GPS golf cart this year, which will allow players to access on screen individual and team scoring, GPS yardage and a flyover view of each hole among other features.

The golf classic, to be held August 22, is Community Health Network of Connecticut Foundation, Inc.'s (Foundation) largest annual fundraising event. The Foundation is a not-for-profit, charitable organization that supports and promotes programs and activities that fundamentally improve the health status of the people living in Connecticut. The golf classic has enabled the Foundation to award more than \$161,000 to Federally Qualified Health Centers and health-related community programs throughout the state over the past five years.

The golf classic is named for Cornell Scott, a founder and board member of the Foundation. Mr. Scott worked at New Haven's Cornell Scott-Hill Health Center for more than 40 years until his passing in 2008. He dedicated his life to addressing the needs of community health while acting as a passionate advocate for the health care needs of the poor.

At the Cornell Scott Memorial Golf Classic, players will not only have the opportunity to play on Lake of Isles' private, members only course, but they will also be able to take advantage of its 50,000 sq. ft. clubhouse, state-of-the-art indoor and outdoor practice facility and its locker room facilities. The course is managed by Troon Golf, a worldwide leader in upscale golf course management, development and marketing known for its superior service and impeccable course conditions.
